Transbay Transit Center

Please join Supervisor Sean Elsbernd, members of the Transbay Joint Powers Authority (TJPA) and the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency to learn more about the plans underway to build the new Transbay Transit Center.

This new Transit Center will replace the current Transbay bus terminal at First and Mission streets in downtown San Francisco with a Grand Central Station of the West. The project will:

- Create a central downtown Transit Center that will connect the San Francisco Bay Area and the State through nine transit systems: AC Transit, BART, Caltrain, Golden Gate Transit, Greyhound, MUNI (including paratransit for seniors and the disabled), WestCAT, SamTrans and future High-Speed Rail
- Extend the Caltrain rail line underground from Fourth and King streets into the new Transit Center
- Build a vibrant new neighborhood surrounding the Transit Center with 3,400 homes (35% affordable)
