<u>Tenderloin Not Last Stop For Pitstop Program:</u> Supervisor Kim Secures Over \$200k for Staffed Public Toilets in District 6

- Who: Supervisor Jane Kim and SF Public Works
- What: Supplemental Appropriation for Staffed Pitstop Public Toilet Program
- When: Supplemental forwarded out of Budget & Finance Committee, headed to full board vote on January 27th
- **Budget:** \$203,200 for 3 Tenderloin toilets and 1 additional SoMa toilet for 2015
- Results of 6 month Pitstop Pilot:
 - o 60% reduction in steam-cleaning requests in Tenderloin
 - o City saves 165 gallons cleaning water a day, 2,640 gallons a month
 - o 275 syringes safely disposed of in first 14 weeks of pilot
 - Toilet useage has more than doubled since the start of pilot
- Unique Public Toilets:
 - o Job creation through staffing & maintenance
 - Monitoring keeps toilets safe & clean
 - o Dog waste and used syringe receptacles for safe disposal
 - Hygienic wash stations ensure cleanliness
 - o Data-driven hours of operation and geographic placement

"This is a model for the rest of the country," said Supervisor Jane Kim, who spearheaded the pilot in partnership with Public Works after receiving resident feedback. "Public toilets are part of keeping a neighborhood healthy, safe and clean, and we are using data to help target the most cost-effective way to address the great need. I'm looking forward to expanding the program to the South of Market."
