160221 [Appropriation - Community Impact Improvement Fees - Eastern Neighborhoods Infrastructure Improvement Projects - \$739,671 - FY2015-2016] Sponsor: Mayor

Ordinance appropriating \$739,671 of Community Improvement Impact Fees revenue to the Recreation and Park Department to support the Eastern Neighborhoods Infrastructure Improvement Projects in FY2015-2016. ASSIGNED to Budget and Finance Committee.

- **160222** [Administrative Code Prohibition on Leasing for the Extraction of Fossil Fuels] Sponsors: Avalos; Breed, Campos, Cohen, Mar, Peskin, Wiener and Yee Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to prohibit the City from entering into or extending leases for the extraction of fossil fuel from City-owned land. ASSIGNED UNDER 30 DAY RULE to Land Use and Transportation Committee.
- **160223 [Declaring Existence of a Shelter Crisis] Sponsors:** Campos; Kim, Avalos, Mar, Yee, Breed and Peskin Ordinance making findings and declaring the existence of a shelter crisis in San Francisco under California Government Code, Sections 8698, et seq. ASSIGNED to Land Use and Transportation Committee.
- 160224 [Appropriation General Fund Reserve for Supporting Portable Restroom Facilities - \$214,260 - FY2015-2016] Sponsors: Kim; Breed Ordinance appropriating \$214,260 from the General Fund Reserve to Public Works Operating Budget in order to support and maintain portable restroom facilities in FY2015-2016. ASSIGNED UNDER 30 DAY RULE to Budget and Finance Sub-Committee.

#### 160225 [Administrative Code - Best Value Public Works Procurement]

#### Sponsors: Wiener; Tang and Breed

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to allow departments authorized to perform public work to procure public work contracts through a best value process that selects contractors using a combination of price and qualifications, with bid discounts applicable to price; and to require completion of public works contractor performance evaluations, and to require the creation and maintenance of a database to collect the contractor performance evaluations. ASSIGNED UNDER 30 DAY RULE to Government Audit and Oversight Committee.

#### 160188 [General Plan Amendment - Downtown Area Plan Map 5 - Portions of Transbay Redevelopment Plan Blocks 1 and 2]

Ordinance amending the General Plan by revising Map 5 of the Downtown Area Plan to include a note stating that the proposed Height and Bulk Districts on Block 1 (Assessor's Parcel Block No. 3740, Lot Nos. 027, 029, 030, 031, and 032), on Folsom Street between Main and Spear Streets, and a portion of Block 2 (Assessor's Parcel Block No. 3739, Lot No. 004), on Folsom and Main Streets, of the Transbay Redevelopment Project Area shall be consistent with those provided in the Transbay Redevelopment Plan Development Controls; and making findings, including findings under the California Environmental Quality Act, and findings of consistency with the General Plan, and the eight priority policies of Planning Code, Section 101.1.
