100427 [Barring the Use of Certain Pesticides for Weed Abatement]

Sponsor: Alioto-Pier

Ordinance amending the San Francisco Environment Code by amending Section 307, to bar the Department of Environment from granting exemptions from the ban on the use of certain pesticides by City departments, where the intended use of the pesticide is solely or primarily for weed abatement, and making environmental findings. ASSIGNED UNDER 30 DAY RULE to City Operations and Neighborhood Services Committee.

100434 [Castro Street Neighborhood Commercial District – Conditional Use Requirements for Restaurants and Self-Service Specialty Food Establishments] Sponsor: Dufty

Ordinance amending the San Francisco Planning Code by amending Section 715.1 and Sections 715.42, 715.43, 715.44, and 715.69A of the Zoning Control Table to allow new full-service and small self-service restaurants with a conditional use authorization, to permit self-service specialty food establishments as of right, and to prohibit all large fast food establishments; adopting findings, including environmental findings; amending Section 302 findings, and findings of consistency with the General Plan and the Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. ASSIGNED UNDER 30 DAY RULE to Land Use and Economic Development Committee.

100437 [Standards of Care for City Shelters and Powers and Duties of the Shelter Monitoring Committee]

Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code by amending Chapter 20, Sections 20.304, 20.401, 20.403, 20.404, and 20.405, to: 1) amend City requirements in the delivery of shelter services to, among other things, expand reservation capability at shelters; provide additional training to shelter staff; and ensure case management services for shelter clients in need; and 2) require the Shelter Monitoring Committee to track refusals of shelter beds and authorize the Committee to initiate investigations into alleged violations of contractual obligations imposed by Chapter 20. 100455 [San Francisco Safe Drug Disposal Ordinance]

Ordinance amending the San Francisco Environment Code by adding Chapter 22, Sections 2201 through 2210, to require any person who produces a drug offered for sale in San Francisco to participate in an approved drug stewardship program for the collection and disposal of unwanted drugs from residential sources, and to provide for implementation, enforcement, fees, and penalties, and making environmental findings.
