##### **111212 [Charter Amendment - Replacing Ranked-Choice Voting with Run-Off Elections]**

**Sponsors:** Farrell; Elsbernd

Charter Amendment (First Draft) to amend the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco by amending Section 13.102 and Article XVII to replace ranked-choice voting with run-off elections. ASSIGNED UNDER 30 DAY RULE to Rules Committee.

##### **111210 [Planning Code - Chinatown Transit Station Special Use District]**

**Sponsor:** Chiu

Ordinance amending the San Francisco Planning Code by adding Section 249.66 to: 1) create the Chinatown Transit Station Special Use District at the southwest corner of Stockton Street and Washington Street (Assessor Block No. 211, Lot No. 1); 2) permit the demolition of a mixed-use building in the Chinatown Neighborhood Commercial District for the construction of the Chinatown Station of the Central Subway; and 3) adopt findings, including General Plan Consistency Findings and findings under the California Environmental Quality Act. ASSIGNED UNDER 30 DAY RULE to Land Use and Economic Development Committee.
