WHEREAS, On September 15, 2010, the Elections Commission requested that the Board of Supervisors waive this prohibition to permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections with the November 2, 2010, election; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, the Board of Supervisors waives the prohibition imposed by Charter section 13.104.5, to permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections before, during, and after the November 2, 2010, election.
