Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Chapter 16, Article 1, Section 16.5, to read as follows:

Sec. 16.5. Cesar Chavez Day. (a) March 31st shall be a holiday, known as "Cesar Chavez Day."

(b) This section shall create a paid holiday for represented employees of the City and County of San Francisco only to the extent allowed by ratified Memoranda of Understanding between the City and the affected recognized employee organizations. This section will not create a paid holiday for City employees until funds have been allocated for such a holiday.

(c) The process for establishing a paid holiday for City employees is the following:

(1) For employees represented by an employee organization whose labor contract (Memorandum of Understanding, or MOU) contains the following, or a similar,

"[A]ny day declared to be a holiday by proclamation of the Mayor after

such day has heretofore been declared a holiday by the Governor...or the President..."
