Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by adding Section 32.6.30, to read as follows:

SEC. 32.6.30. PARKING CONTROL, PORTION OF GREEN STREET. No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, on the north side of Green Street, from 15 feet to 75 feet east of Baker Street (60-foot zone), except official vehicles displaying a valid permit issued by the Russian Embassy authorizing parking in said zone. The permit exceptions under this Section shall not apply when parking prohibition regulations for street-cleaning purposes are in effect.
