3 WHEREAS, In November 1991, the voters of San Francisco enacted a charter
4 amendment which established the San Francisco's Children's Fund; and

5 WHEREAS, The provision of this section requires that the City revenues set aside for the
6 Fund be used exclusively to provide services to children, less than 18 years of age, above and
7 beyond services funded prior to the adoption of the amendment, and

8 WHEREAS, This section further requires the Health Commission, Juvenile Probation
9 Commission, Human Services Commission, Public Library Commission, Recreation and
10 Parks Commission and Youth Commission to hold public hearings on the Plan and those hearings were or
11 will be held on November 17, 1999, November 18, 1999, December 6, 1999 and December 7, 1999,
12 respectively; and

13 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors provides important oversight for the Children's
14 Fund, and is acutely aware that accountability to the public is of critical importance in a fund that
15 was created by the voters; and

16 WHEREAS, In accordance with Charter Section ^{16.108}~~16.018~~, the Mayor has submitted a
17 Children's Services Plan that proposes goals and objectives for the Fund and designates the
18 Department of Children, Youth and Their Families (DCYF) for the administration of the Fund
19 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999; now therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors approve the 2000-2002 Children's Services
21 Plan submitted by the Mayor in accordance with Charter Section ^{16.108}~~16.018~~ a copy of which is on
22 file at the Office of the Clerk to the San Francisco Board of Supervisors.
