URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SECOND CYCLE TEA21 FUNDS FOR VAN NESS AVENUE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, Van Ness Avenue is a wide street with near freeway volumes of traffic, making the street difficult for many pedestrians to cross comfortably; and,

WHEREAS, The Van Ness Avenue Pedestrian Safety Improvements project aims to improve pedestrian safety by upgrading median islands to encourage their use as safe waiting areas; and,

WHEREAS, The project will also construct sidewalk bulbs to decrease the walking distance to cross Van Ness Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has received a federal grant for the project which will allow the construction of 17 islands and 10 bulbs; and,

WHEREAS, An increase in the cost of the project due to construction of sewers and new catch basins, monitoring of the sewer excavation by an archaeologist, weekend sewer work, and the cost of routing MUNI trolley buses on weekends, has resulted in a funding shortfall of \$700,000; and,

WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has applied to the San Francisco County Transportation Authority to receive second cycle TEA 21 funds to cover the \$700,000 needed to construct the remaining 20 bulbs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the San Francisco County Transportation Authority to provide second cycle TEA21 funds for Van Ness Avenue Pedestrian Safety Improvements.
