5 SERVICES AND TECHNOLOGY ACT (LSTA). FUNDS WILL BE USED TO REIMBURSE
6 TUITION EXPENSES OF LIBRARY EMPLOYEES PURSUING A DEGREE OR
7 CERTIFICATE IN LIBRARY SCIENCE AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.
8 EMPLOYEES PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM APPLIED TO, AND WERE
9 SELECTED BY, THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY.

12 WHEREAS, The California State Library's Public Library Staff Education Program is
13 dedicated to providing tuition reimbursement for library staff pursuing a degree or certification in
14 Library Science, and

15 WHEREAS, four non-professional employees of San Francisco Public applied to the
16 California State Library to participate and receive specific tuition reimbursement amounts and
17 were accepted into the program, and

18 WHEREAS, The California State Library has awarded \$6,546 to San Francisco Public
19 Library to reimburse the student/employees for Fall 1999, Spring 2000, and Summer 2000
20 Tuition fees, including indirect costs, and

21 WHEREAS, The student employees will provide to San Francisco Public Library
22 personnel office official transcripts of completion and registration fee receipts as evidence of

completing said classes prior to receiving reimbursements, and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Library has a goal of promoting equal access to professional development opportunities for employees in order to better serve the public, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Public Library, be authorized to accept and expend \$6,546 awarded by the California State Library, Public Library Staff Education Program, part of the Federal Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA), to reimburse Library Science Education Tuition Fees for participating employees.


