7 February 17th, 2000 and in five years it has become the world's largest center for lesbian, gay,
8 bisexual, transgender and queer studies; and,

9 WHEREAS, The Harvey Milk Institute offers educational opportunities to students in
10 the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transsexual, transgender, and queer communities with course
11 offerings encompassing practical, artistic, cultural and intellectual aspects of queer studies
12 and in a short span of time it has become a leading institution in the growing field of
13 community-based queer education; and,

14 WHEREAS, In its first five years, the Harvey Milk Institute has already offered more
15 than 800 different workshops and courses and had more than 10,000 enrollments, it has
16 supported and recognized the work of artists, photographers, poets, writers, activists,
17 comedians, performance artists, dancers, historians and dozens of Bay Area queer
18 organizations, and showed thousands of people from around the globe why the Bay Area
19 truly is a queer Mecca for queer arts, culture, education and politics; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby commends the Harvey
21 Milk Institute for its important work in education and community empowerment; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco is proud to join the




