URGING THE RECREATION AND PARK COMMISSION TO APPROVE SITING A COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS FUELING STATION INSIDE GATE 11 AT THE SAN FRANCISCO MARINA HARBOR.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is committed to promoting clean air and clean water solutions for transportation options; and,

WHEREAS, Each year two-stroke boat engines discharge approximately 15 times more water pollution nationally than the Exxon Valdez oil spill; and,

WHEREAS, U.S. EPA estimates that one hour of operation by a 70-horsepower two stroke motor emits the same amount of hydrocarbon pollution as driving 5,000 miles in a recent-year automobile; and,

WHEREAS, There are currently no other boats in San Francisco Bay that run on compressed natural gas (CNG), even though this technology is available; similarly, CNG fuel pumps are increasingly available for cars but none have been installed in the Bay Area to service boats; and,

WHEREAS, By November, and effective in 2006, the 1990 Clean Air Act mandates the Environmental Protection Agency to set standards to reduce emissions from diesel-powered marine engines by nearly fifty percent; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco BayKeeper, is a San Francisco-based non-profit organization that has effectively advocated for improved water quality in the Bay and Delta for over a decade; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco BayKeeper currently owns and operates a 26' boat which is used for water quality monitoring, public education and patrols for illicit dischargers and which may be run on compressed natural gas; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco BayKeeper has agreed to accept liability for obtaining, installing, and if necessary, removing a compressed natural gas pump at the Marina Harbor and shall ensure that the installation complies with federal, state and local codes; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco BayKeeper agrees that it will share use of the pump with the City if, at any time in the future, the City elects to use a natural gas powered boat (assuming the City agrees to pay its fair share of using and maintaining the pump); and,

WHEREAS, Department of Parks and Recreation staff have identified an appropriate location inside Gate 11 at the San Francisco Marina where the pump may be installed and used without losing an existing berth; and,

WHEREAS, Environmental health is a high priorities for immediate attention in the City and County of San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby urge the Recreation and Park Commission approve siting a compressed natural gas fueling station inside gate 11 at the San Francisco Marina Harbor; be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be sent to the Recreation and Park Commission, McLaren Lodge.
