5 WHEREAS, Soulforce is an interfaith organization seeking justice for sexual minorities;

7 WHEREAS, Soulforce is determined to help end the suffering of lesbian, gay, bisexual,  
8 and transgendered persons and to help change the minds and hearts of religious leaders  
9 whose anti-homosexual campaigns lead, directly and indirectly, to that suffering; and,

10 WHEREAS, Soulforce is guided in its every action by the principles of nonviolent  
11 resistance as lived and taught by M.K. Gandhi and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr; and,

12 WHEREAS, On May 10, 2000, Soulforce will lead hundreds of volunteers in a march  
13 for gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender rights and a non-violent civil disobedience at the  
14 United Methodist General Conference in Cleveland, Ohio; and,

15 WHEREAS, The purpose of the march and act of civil disobedience is to force the  
16 United Methodist General Conference to take a stand for justice and truth on behalf of sexual  
17 minorities; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
19 commends Soulforce for its May 10, 2000 march for gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender  
20 rights.




