10 pollution and decrease fuel consumption; and

11 WHEREAS, Bike-to-Work days have proven effective in converting
12 drivers into bicyclists and educating citizens about the
13 environmental importance of biking to work regularly; and

14 WHEREAS, San Francisco encourages its citizens to bike to work,
15 in order to improve air quality and promote the health benefits of
16 cycling; and

17 WHEREAS, Cities and counties throughout California are promoting
18 May 15-19, 2000, as a statewide bike-to-work week known as
19 "California Bike Commute 2000"; and,

20 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Bicycle Coalition, The American Lung
21 Association, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD),
22 the California Bicycle Coalition, Metropolitan Transportation
23 Commission, and RIDES for Bay Area Commuters are promoting May 15-19,
24 2000, as the Bay Area's Bike-to- Work Week; now,

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the
2 week of May 15-19, 2000, San Francisco Bike-to-Work Week, to help
3 promote a clean means of transportation, helping to reduce air


