[Commending Canadian Broadcast Standards Council]

COMMENDING THE CANADIAN BROADCAST STANDARDS COUNCIL FOR REBUKING LAURA SCHLESSINGER'S ANTI-GAY RADIO BROADCAST AND UPHOLDING THE DIGNITY AND HUMAN RIGHTS OF LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL AND TRANSGENDER INDIVIDUALS AS WELL AS IMPLEMENTING PROACTIVE MEASURES TO MITIGATE POTENTIAL VIOLENCE DIRECTED AT INDIVIDUALS WHO EITHER ARE OR PERCEIVED TO BE LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL OR TRANSGENDER.

WHEREAS, The Canadian Broadcast Standards Council (CBSC) is comprised of 430 private Canadian radio and television shows throughout Canada; and

WHEREAS, The CBSC unanimously condemned the anti-gay content of Laura Schlessinger's radio broadcast and publicly rebuked Laura Schlessinger for openly violating Canada's provisions regarding human rights; and

WHEREAS, Laura Schlessinger publicly stated that the behavior of gays, lesbians, bisexuals and transgender individuals was abnormal, aberrant, disordered, dysfunctional, deviant; and that gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender individuals were a biological error; and

WHEREAS, The CBSC stated that because Schlessinger broadcasts from a powerful and influential medium, the cumulative effects of her anti-gay views may contribute to the creation of a negative social environment, hatred targeted the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender community, potentially incite violent acts directed at individuals or groups who are or are perceived to be gay ; and

WHEREAS, To willfully promote hatred against an identifiable group such as racial, religious, and ethnic minorities as well as sexual minority groups is deemed a criminal offense in Canada ; and

WHEREAS, The CSBS further stated that the sexual practices of gays and lesbians are as much a part of one's being as the color one's skin or the gender, religion, age or ethnicity of an individual and further that Schlessinger's use of such brutal language regarding an individual's essential characteristic is antithetical to Canada's human rights provisions; and

WHEREAS, The CSBS also equated Schlessinger's treatment of gays with racist speech targeting minority groups and noted that professional psychiatric and psychological associations regard Schlessinger's views of gay as being more than 25 years out of date; and

WHEREAS, The CSBS further required all participating radio and television stations to filter and censor any anti-gay statements made on her show on all future broadcast in addition to requiring all participating stations that air Schlessinger's shows to broadcast statements on the CSBS ruling during their prime-time broadcast; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends the Canadian Broadcast Standards Council for publicly rebuking Laura Schlessinger's anti-gay radio broadcasts and upholding and defending the dignity and human rights of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender individuals; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors further commends the Canadian Broadcast Standards Council for implementing proactive measures to mitigate potential violence directed at individuals who either are or are perceived to be lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender individuals.
