SUPPLEMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR THE EXECUTIVE PARK
DEVELOPMENT AND ADOPTING ENVIRONMENTAL FINDINGS (AND A STATEMENT OF
OVERRIDING CONSIDERATIONS) PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL
QUALITY ACT AND STATE GUIDELINES IN CONNECTION WITH THE ADOPTION OF
AMENDMENTS TO THE GENERAL PLAN

ENDORSING THE PLANNING COMMISSION'S CERTIFICATION OF THE FINAL

WHEREAS, the Executive Park Area is a subarea of the South Bayshore Area Plan of the General Plan, and is situated near the southeastern boundary of the City and County of San Francisco and bounded by Highway 101, Bayview Park, Jamestown Avenue and Harney Way and comprises San Francisco Assessor's Block 4991, Lots 24, 61, 65, 74, 75, 85, 86 and 88/90 ("Executive Park Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Executive Park Area consists of approximately 71 acres and has been partially developed pursuant to a zoning reclassification in 1976 (Resolutions No. 7544, 7546, 7547); a Development Plan approval in 1978 (Resolution 9089); and Conditional Use Authorizations for Planned Unit Development in 1985 and 1992 (Motions 10461 and 13304, respectively); and

WHEREAS, the Executive Park Development Plan and the approved development referred to above were examined prior to approval in the San Francisco Executive Park General Plan Final Environmental Impact Report (Case No. EE75.198, certified August 12, 1976) (the "1976 FEIR"), the Executive Park Development Plan Amendment Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (Case No. 81.97E, certified October 17, 1985) ("1985 FSEIR"), as supplemented by the addendum to the 1985 FSEIR (Case No. 90.299E, dated February 13, 1992) ("1992 Addendum"); and

WHEREAS, the Project Sponsor has submitted an application for amendments to the General Plan and for a conditional use authorization for a planned unit development to permit completion of the development for the Executive Park Area, ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the amendments to the General Plan and the conditional use authorization constitute a portion of the actions, considerations and decisions to be made in connection with the Project ("Actions") as more particularly described in Attachment A, "Executive Park Development Plan, California Environmental Quality Act Findings, Board of Supervisors for the City and county of San Francisco," which is incorporated into this Resolution by reference, and a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File

No. 000739 ; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department ("Department") has undertaken an environmental review process for the proposed Project and provided for appropriate public hearings before the San Francisco Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, on July 31, 1999, the Department released for public review and comment the Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Report, File 1999.442E ("1999 Draft SEIR") and on September 2, 1999, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the 1999 Draft SEIR and further written comments were received until 5:00 p.m. September 14, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has prepared a Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report ("1999 FSEIR") for the Project consisting of the Draft SEIR, the comments received during the review period, any additional information that became available and the Draft Summary of Comments and Responses, all as required by law; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 1999, the Planning Commission reviewed and considered the 1999 FSEIR and, by Motion No. 14935, found that the contents of said report and the procedures through which the 1999 FSEIR was prepared, publicized and reviewed complied ///

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with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the CEQA Guidelines in Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, by Motion No. 14935, the Planning Commission found the 1999 FSEIR was adequate, accurate and objective, reflected the independent analysis and judgment of the Department of City Planning and the Commission and that the summary of comments and responses contained no significant revisions to the draft supplemental environmental impact report, adopted findings of significant impacts associated with the Project and certified the completion of the final supplemental environmental impact report for the Project in compliance with CEQA and the CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2000, the Department of City Planning issued a Memorandum to City Planning File 1999.442E pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15164 including an Addendum to the 1999 FSEIR for the Project ("Addendum"), determining that a technical correction of lot numbers defining the Project area as set forth in the 1999 FSEIR and a change in the Project increasing the child care space from 10,000 square feet to 13,240 square feet would not result in any new significant environmental effects beyond those disclosed and analyzed in the 1999 FSEIR, that no new information has become available since certification of the 1999 FSEIR that would require major revisions to the 1999 FSEIR or its conclusions, that there are no substantial changes with respect to the circumstances under which the Project is to be undertaken since the certification of the 1999 FSEIR that would cause new significant environmental impacts and that no further environmental analysis is required for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the 1999 FSEIR files, the Addendum and other Project-related Department files have been made available for review by this Planning Commission and the public, and those files are part of the record before this Planning Commission; and

 WHEREAS, the Department has prepared proposed Executive Park Findings, as required by CEQA, which are contained in Attachment A, including Exhibits 1 through 3, regarding the alternatives and variants, mitigation measures and significant environmental impacts analyzed in the 1999 FSEIR, as well as overriding considerations for approving the Project and a proposed mitigation monitoring program, which material was made available to the public and the Board of Supervisors for the Board's review, consideration and action; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered Planning Commission Motion 14935 certifying the 1999 FSEIR and finding the 1999 FSEIR adequate, accurate and objective, and reflecting the independent judgment and analysis of the Planning Commission, and hereby endorses and adopts Planning Commission Motion 14935 and incorporates the same herein by this reference; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That based upon the Board of Supervisor's review of the 1999 FSEIR, and Addendum, the Board finds that (1) modifications incorporated into the Project from the description contained in the 1999 FSEIR will not require important revisions to the 1999 FSEIR due to the involvement of new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects; (2) no substantial changes have occurred with respect to the circumstances under which the Project is to be undertaken which would require major revisions to the 1999 FSEIR due to the involvement of significant effects or a substantial increase in the severity of effects identified in the 1999 FSEIR; and (3) no new information of substantial importance to the Project has become available which would indicate (a) the Project or the actions will have significant effects not discussed in the 1999 FSEIR, (b) significant environmental effects would be substantially more severe, (c) mitigation measures or alternatives found not feasible which would reduce one or more significant effects have become feasible, or (d) mitigation measures or alternatives which are

considerably different from those in the 1999 FSEIR would substantially reduce one or more significant effects on the environment; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the 1999 FSEIR and the Addendum and hereby adopts the Executive Park Findings attached hereto as Attachment A, including its Exhibits 1 through 3, a copy of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ______ and incorporates the same herein by this reference.
