[WAIVER OF FEES]

WAIVING THE ^{\$6,405}~~\$5,000~~ FEE FOR SERVICES FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, FIRE DEPARTMENT, RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, AND DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC, AND A \$5,000 PERFORMANCE BOND ASSOCIATED WITH THE JUNETEENTH RODEO ON JUNE 10, 2000 AND CELEBRATION ON JUNE 17 - 18, 2000.

WHEREAS, Juneteenth, the oldest known celebration of the ending of slavery, commemorates June 19th when Union soldiers landed at Galveston, Texas with news that the Civil War had ended and that all slaves were freed with the signing of the Emancipation Proclamation; and,

WHEREAS, The Juneteenth tradition has been celebrated in the State of California since the 1930s as African Americans began to migrate west from Texas and elsewhere; and,

WHEREAS, This event realized no profit in 1998, nor in 1999, and is not projected to make a profit this year according to the Juneteenth Committee 2000, this year's sponsoring organization; and,

WHEREAS, The projected costs associated with services provided by the Police Department, Fire Department, Recreation and Park Department, Department of Public Health, and Department of Parking and Traffic for the events has been calculated as follows: ^{\$6,405}~~\$5,000~~ for fees and \$5,000 for a performance bond, for a total of \$10,000; and,


