RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, urges the San Francisco Board of Education to place the highest priority on the renovation of Bessie Carmichael Elementary School; and be it

FUTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the San Francisco
Board of Education not to approve any new school construction until the Bessie Carmichel
Renovation Project is completed; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the Superintendent of the San Francisco Unified School District to include the Bessie Carmichael Elementary School Renovation Project in the next facilities bond measure to be presented to the voters of San Francisco.
