5 Boulder, CO to lay the groundwork for an expanded, activist gay men's health movement in  
6 the United States; and,

7 WHEREAS, The first Gay Men's Health Summit tackled health issues ranging from  
8 prostate cancer and chronic depression to HIV and substance abuse; and,

9 WHEREAS, The second annual Gay Men's Health Summit will be held July 19-23 in  
10 Boulder, CO; and,

11 WHEREAS, In addition to examining the health challenges facing gay male  
12 communities, the second summit will also address the importance of love, celebration,  
13 spirituality, wellness, and joy in combating health challenges; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Gay Men's Health Summit will continue to emphasize the need to  
15 improve communication among gay men of different cultures, generations, races, locations,  
16 abilities, and HIV statuses; and,

17 WHEREAS, Instead of a national Gay Men's Health Summit in 2001, the year will be  
18 devoted to local and regional organizing of day-long or weekend-long gay men's health  
19 summits; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
21 commends the second annual Gay Men's Health Summit.
