CONCURRING WITH CONTROLLER'S CERTIFICATION THAT CONVENTION FACILITIES MANAGEMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES CAN BE PRACTICALLY PERFORMED AT BILL GRAHAM CIVIC AUDITORIUM AND MOSCONE CENTER BY PRIVATE CONTRACTOR FOR LOWER COST THAN SIMILAR WORK SERVICES PERFORMED BY CITY AND COUNTY EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed Proposition J in November, 1976 adding Section 8.300-1 to the Charter allowing City Departments to contract with private companies for specific services which can be practically performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and County employees; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Administrative Services has previously sought and received approval of the Board of Supervisors to contract with the Moscone Joint Venture under the provision of Proposition J and now wishes to fund the contract for the management, operation and maintenance services for 2000-01; and

WHEREAS, the Controller has certified on June 14, 2000 that said services can be performed at a lower cost to the City than by employees of the City and County; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's certification and approves that the Director of Administrative Services may contract for management, operation and maintenance services for Bill Graham Civic Auditorium and Moscone Center.


