AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT TO APPLY FOR \$72,450 FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A GREEN BUILDING TOOL KIT AND TRAINING WORKSHOPS.

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code Section 42000 authorizes the California
Integrated Waste Management Board to conduct market development activities to strengthen
demand by manufacturers and end-use consumers for recyclable materials collected by
municipalities, nonprofit organizations, and private entities; and,

WHEREAS, the concept of *Sustainable Buildings*, also referred to as *Green Buildings*, is an integrated approach which encompasses integrated waste management objectives such as building material efficiency, construction and demolition waste reduction, and maximization of reused- and recycled-content building and landscaping materials; and,

WHEREAS, on October 20, 1999 the California Integrated Waste Management Board approved of the Sustainable Building Implementation Plan, the Evaluation Process, Scoring Criteria, and Preference Criteria for the Sustainable Building Grant Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of the Environment intends to apply for funding of \$72,450 for the development of a Green Building toolkit and a series of workshops; and,

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board requires that all applicants for the Sustainable Building Grant Program must submit an "apply for" resolution to the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco project sponsors who are designated to receive funds shall subsequently submit all required additional information for the Board of Supervisor's consideration of an "accept and expend" resolution; and,

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors\_authorizes the Director of the Department of the Environment to apply for funding of \$72,450 from the California Integrated Waste Management Board for a Sustainable Building Grant. The Director of the Department of the Environment, or their designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City and County of San Francisco all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements and amendments hereto for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant application.
