16 should receive a living wage, good benefits as well as to work in a healthy and safe

18 WHEREAS, It is the also the desire of the City and County of San Francisco to express  
19 its appreciation to the messenger community for the vital contributions to the City's economy  
20 as well as to commemorate the messengers who have past away while carrying out their  
21 duties; now therefore be it


