WHEREAS, The continuing grant enhances the capacity of the District Attorney's Office to prosecute domestic violence offenses; and,

WHEREAS, AB801, Chapter 599, Statutes of 1994, authorized the Department of Justice to provide grants to county District Attorney's Offices for the purpose of prosecuting and convicting individuals arrested for spousal abuse crimes; and,

WHEREAS, The California Department of Justice requires that the City and County of San Francisco, through the Office of the District Attorney shall provide no less than a twenty percent in-kind match for the grant; and,

WHEREAS, The California Department of Justice does not allow use of grant funds for indirect costs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney to accept and expend a Spousal Abuser Prosecution grant up to \$120,000 from the California Department of Justice to fund prosecution related to domestic violence; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee. The State of California and the Department of Justice disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That any grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local funds that would, in the absence of the Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program, be made available to support the prosecution of individuals accused of domestic violence; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, deliver and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the purpose of securing Spousal Abuser Prosecution grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant application.
