

1 [Accept-Expend State Spousal Abuser Prosecution Grant]
2 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY
3 OF SAN FRANCISCO TO RETROACTIVELY ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE
4 AMOUNT OF \$120,000 FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR A
5 PROGRAM ENTITLED "SPOUSAL ABUSER PROSECUTION PROGRAM", AND WAIVING
6 INDIRECT COSTS.

7 WHEREAS, The continuing grant enhances the capacity of the
8 District Attorney's Office to prosecute domestic violence offenses;
9 and,

10 WHEREAS, AB801, Chapter 599, Statutes of 1994, authorized the
11 Department of Justice to provide grants to county District Attorney's
12 Offices for the purpose of prosecuting and convicting individuals
13 arrested for spousal abuse crimes; and,

14 WHEREAS, The California Department of Justice requires that the
15 City and County of San Francisco, through the Office of the District
16 Attorney shall provide no less than a twenty percent in-kind match
17 for the grant; and,

18 WHEREAS, The California Department of Justice does not allow use
19 of grant funds for indirect costs; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the
21 District Attorney to accept and expend a Spousal Abuser Prosecution
22 grant up to \$120,000 from the California Department of Justice to
23 fund prosecution related to domestic violence; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives
25 inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising
2 out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil
3 court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the
4 grantee. The State of California and the Department of Justice
5 disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and be it


6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any grant funds received hereunder shall
7 not be used to supplant local funds that would, in the absence of the
8 Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program, be made available to support the
9 prosecution of individuals accused of domestic violence; and be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is hereby
11 authorized and empowered to execute, deliver and perform, in the name
12 of the City and County of San Francisco, all applications, contracts,
13 agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the purpose
14 of securing Spousal Abuser Prosecution grant funds and to implement
15 and carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant
16 application.


