16 WHEREAS, Mr. Hay will be visiting from October 14 through October 21
17 and will be traveling with a group of international students taking
18 part in a research project; and,

20 WHEREAS, These students from Sweden, Germany, the Czech Republic,
21 Japan, Korea, and South Africa have all saved up their own funds to
22 travel to the United States to visit San Francisco and the Stinking
23 Rose; and,

24 WHEREAS, Stinking Rose owners Jerry Dal Bozzo, Dean Dal Bozzo, Dante
25 Serafini and Vince Bigone have taken extraordinary measures to ensure


