2 AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND
TRAFFIC TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF ~~\$600,000~~ ^{\$742,000} FROM THE

3 FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION AND THE CALIFORNIA STATE DEPARTMENT
4 OF TRANSPORTATION TO ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF
5 THE CITY CARSHARE PROGRAM.

8 WHEREAS, On October 15, 1999, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors passed
9 resolution number 905-99 urging that carsharing become a component of the City's "Transit
10 First" policy and urging various City departments to aid in the development and administration
11 of the City CarShare program; and,

12 WHEREAS, San Francisco Planning and Urban Research, Urban Ecology, and the
13 San Francisco Bicycle Coalition have laid the foundation for the City CarShare program; and,

14 WHEREAS, The City CarShare program recently was awarded \$742,000 by the Value
15 Pricing Pilot Program for development and implementation (\$600,000) and evaluation
16 (\$142,000) of carsharing in San Francisco; and,

17 WHEREAS, This grant supports the development of carsharing, a neighborhood based
18 mobility service that makes cars and trucks available to people on a per-use basis, thereby
19 making it practical for many City residents and workers to forego private automobile
20 ownership; and,

21 WHEREAS, Carsharing has proven to be an effective way to provide people with
22 access to an automobile without the need to purchase, insure, and park an automobile; and,

23 WHEREAS, This grant will assist the City in addressing the challenge of providing both
24 adequate parking and reducing City traffic; and,

2 contract administrator for the City CarShare program and the fiscal agent for this grant
3 awarded to the City CarShare program; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
5 authorizes the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic to accept and
6 expend a grant in the amount of ^{\$742,000}~~\$600,000~~ from the Federal Highway Administration and the
7 California State Department of Transportation to assist in the development and administration
8 of the City CarShare program; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Executive Director is hereby authorized and
10 empowered to execute, deliver, and perform, in the name of the City and County of San
11 Francisco, all applications, contracts, agreements, amendments, and payment requests
12 necessary for the purpose of securing the grant funds and to carry out the purpose specified
13 in the applicable grant application.




