3 **Resolution commending the contributions of Judy Lemons to the City and County of**
4 **San Francisco, the state of California, and the United States of America and declaring**
5 **January 3, 2001 "Judy Lemons Day" in San Francisco.**

7 WHEREAS, Judy Lemons has dedicated herself to public service for over 25 years,
8 serving on the staff of Congressman Phillip Burton from 1974 until 1983; Congresswoman
9 Sala Burton from 1983 until 1987; and serving as Administrative Assistant to Congresswoman
10 Nancy Pelosi from 1987 until the present; and,

11 WHEREAS, during this time period she has risen through the ranks to become one of
12 the most respected Congressional staff members in the United States Congress; and,

13 WHEREAS, Judy has been a stalwart in Congress on issues of the environment,
14 working to enlarge the Golden Gate National Recreation Area, and helping to create the Gulf
15 of the Farallones Marine Sanctuary, National Maritime Museum and many other conservation
16 resources; and

17 WHEREAS, Judy fought a courageous and successful fight inside the congressional
18 committee structure to create the Presidio Trust and to prevent attempts to sell San
19 Francisco's Presidio to the highest bidder and;

20 WHEREAS, Judy has been an invaluable advocate for San Francisco on its many
21 appropriations issues, including the Port, UCSF, Airport, and its many transportation needs;

23 WHEREAS, Judy has worked on regional issues such as bay dredging to ensure the
24 economic health of the Bay Area while protecting the ecosystem of our Bay; and

1 WHEREAS, Judy was instrumental in facilitating appointments to the advisory
2 committee of the GGNRA as a liaison between the environmental community and the Park
3 community; and

4 WHEREAS, most recently Judy was instrumental in changing the law governing the
5 Golden Gate National Recreation Area to allow the transfer of Parcel 4 in San Francisco's
6 Ocean Beach area into the GGNRA; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby commends Judy
8 Lemons for her contributions to our City, our state, and our country; and be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of San Francisco hereby declares
10 January 3rd, the opening of the 107th Congress, as "Judy Lemons Day" in San Francisco.
