7 WHEREAS, In 1989 the Loma Prieta earthquake damaged Parkside School and made  
8 it unsuitable for schoolchildren; and

9 WHEREAS, The number of young children in the Sunset has increased tremendously;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS, The School District, in recognition of the need to serve these children,  
12 proposed the rebuilding of Parkside School and construction of a new childcare center for  
13 inclusion in a school bond measure; and,

14 WHEREAS, In 1997 San Francisco voters passed this bond measure which included  
15 11 million dollars for the Parkside School and child care center; and,

16 WHEREAS, The groundbreaking for the Parkside School and childcare center has  
17 been delayed for more than one year; and,

18 WHEREAS, The price of construction has escalated due to the delays; and,

19 WHEREAS, The need for a grade school and child care center is greater than ever;  
20 now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
22 urges the San Francisco Unified School District to make the rebuilding of Parkside School  
23 and construction of a new childcare center a top priority.


