

1 [Branch Library Facilities Improvement Bond Oversight and Reporting.]

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3 **Resolution urging the San Francisco Public Library to create a Bond Oversight**
4 **Committee for the Branch Library Bond, and requesting the San Francisco Public**
5 **Library issue reports to the Board of Supervisors, the Budget Analysts Office, the**
6 **Controller, and the Mayor's Office of Public Finance on a quarterly basis which detail**
7 **all expenditures from the bond funds by facility and by individual projects.**

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9 WHEREAS, On November 7, 2000, the voters of the City and County of San Francisco
10 passed Proposition A, The Branch Library Facilities Improvement Bond Program, which
11 authorized \$105,865,000 in bonds for the acquisition, rehabilitation, renovation, improvement,
12 construction and reconstruction of improvements to branch libraries, other than the Main
13 Library; and,

14 WHEREAS, The bond program provides funding for the improvement of 19 branch
15 libraries, the acquisition of land and construction of buildings for four branch libraries currently
16 located on leased facilities, the construction of a new branch library to serve Mission Bay, and
17 the rehabilitation of Brooks Hall for use by the Public Library; and,

18 WHEREAS, Proposition A specifically prohibited the Public Library from using any of
19 the Proposition A monies on improvements to the Main Library; and,

20 WHEREAS, The Public Library is currently planning the implementation of the Branch
21 Library Facilities Improvement Bond Program, and as part of this process is considering the
22 creation of a Bond Oversight Committee; and,

23 WHEREAS, It is important that there is an oversight body to ensure that the bond
24 funds are spent in accordance with the legislation approved by the voters, and that all of the
25 branch library projects promised to the voters are competed; and,

8 Controller, and the Mayor's Office of Finance on a quarterly basis which detail all
9 expenditures from the bond funds by facility and by individual projects.
