4 WHEREAS, For 25 years, Coleman Advocates, one of the oldest
5 child advocacy organizations in the country, has been one of San
6 Francisco's strongest voices for the City's children and youth; and,

7 WHEREAS, Coleman Advocates sponsored the grassroots campaign
8 that created the landmark Children's Amendment in 1991, making San
9 Francisco the first city in the country to guarantee annual funding
10 for children and youth; and,

11 WHEREAS, Coleman Advocates has developed a nationally recognized
12 model for leadership development for youth and parents through its
13 "Youth Making A Change" and "Parent Advocates for Youth" groups; and,

14 WHEREAS, Coleman Advocates' pioneering advocacy work has been
15 the catalyst for creating such innovative programs such as Larkin
16 Street Youth Center, Family Support Services of the Bay Area, Beacon
17 Schools, and the Youth Line; and,

18 WHEREAS, Coleman Advocates' multi-year early childhood campaign
19 has helped make San Francisco's creative child care policies and
20 programs a national model, particularly the City's SF CARES and
21 WAGES+ programs, and the Child Care Facilities Fund; and,

22 WHEREAS, Coleman Advocates has developed creative civic
23 engagement approaches, such as "Speak Up for Kids Day" at City Hall
24 and the Campaign for Kids to involve more youth, parents, and
25 neighborhood groups in advocacy on behalf of the city's children and
youth; and,


