14 WHEREAS, Four years ago, the California State Automobile Association established  
15 the Employee Volunteer Program, which encourages the participation of both AAA employees  
16 and AAA members in community-based activities; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Employee Volunteer Program's main objectives include building  
18 closer ties to members and their communities, promoting goodwill, and enhancing morale  
19 among employees; and,

20 WHEREAS, The California State Automobile Association's volunteer activities in 2000  
21 include sponsoring the San Francisco AIDS Walk, the Race for the Cure, and American Heart  
22 Walks, and participation in Big Brothers Big Sisters Bowl for Kid's Sake, American Cancer  
23 Society's Relay for Life, Daffodil Days, Christmas in April, and Project Open Hand; and,

24 WHEREAS, The California State Automobile Association also established the AAA  
25 Outdoor Corps to provide environmental awareness; and


