13 working relentlessly to improve accessibility to the Portola community by pushing successfully
14 to reopen the Silver Avenue on and off ramp after the 101/280 retrofit work; and,

15 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Organizing Project-St. Elizabeth Chapter has
16 reorganized the Merchants Association so that merchants could take advantage of a pilot
17 façade improvement program funded by the city; and,

18 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Organizing Project-St. Elizabeth Chapter has been
19 working to beautify Portola by planting trees and improve maintenance on San Bruno Ave,
20 Silver and the Alemany Circle; and,

21 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Organizing Project-St. Elizabeth Chapter has also
22 worked to enhance pedestrian safety by getting a stop light at San Bruno Avenue and Bacon
23 Street and crosswalk ladder striping on San Bruno Avenue at Bacon and Burrow Street now,
