8 WHEREAS, Harry Bridges was the founder of one of the democratic labor
9 organizations of the 20th century, the International Longshoremen's and Warehousemen's
10 Union, and served as its President for forty years; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Bridges also served with distinction as a San Francisco Port
12 Commissioner from 1970 to 1982; and,

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Bridges was a legendary figure whose courage and devotion to
14 principles will never be forgotten, whose passion and dedication to the welfare of working
15 men and women never waned; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Bridges fought racism and discrimination wherever he found it, and
17 fought to strengthen democracy and achieve a permanent peace in the world, and

18 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco is proud to call him one of our
19 community's leaders over several decades; and

20 WHEREAS, July 28, 2001 will mark the 100th anniversary of Harry's birth; now,
21 therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors declare July 28, 2001 Harry
23 Bridges Day, to commemorate the 100th birthday of this great man.




