7 **Resolution declaring the policy that the Continuum of Care Plan 2001-2006 is the City**
8 **and County of San Francisco's official homeless policy document governing the**
9 **development of an integrated, effective and coordinated system of health care,**
10 **housing, employment and support services to end homelessness.**

12 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors established the Local Homeless
13 Coordinating Board via Resolution 827-97 to function as a city-wide advisory body on the
14 issue of homelessness, and to develop sound plans and policies; and

15 WHEREAS, To ensure maximum participation from all sectors and communities, the
16 Local Homeless Coordinating Board has hosted dozens of community meetings involving all
17 the key stakeholders through working groups in the formation of a policy document that
18 reflects the shared values of San Franciscans; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Draft Continuum of Care Plan 2001-2006 is on file with the Clerk of
20 the Board of Supervisors in File No. 010889 , which is hereby declared to be a part of this
21 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

22 WHEREAS, The implementation of the plan will occur through grant applications, the
23 enactment of new policies and appropriate funding of services and programs; now, therefore,
24 be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
2 finds and declares that the Continuum of Care Plan is the City and County of San Francisco's
3 homeless policy document governing the development of an integrated, effective and
4 coordinated system of health care, housing, employment, and support services to end
5 homelessness; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Local Homeless Coordinating Board is staffed by the
7 Mayor's Office on Homelessness; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors recognizes the role of the Local
9 Board as a city-wide homeless program and policy advisory body, and will therefore seriously
10 consider its recommendations when hearing any and all matters before the Board of
11 Supervisors directly or indirectly related to homeless programs and policies; and

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Plan is subject to revision and change as Federal,
13 State and local priorities for preventing and reducing homelessness change and the Local
14 Homeless Coordinating Board shall be charged with amending and updating the plan as
15 necessary and after evaluation of the progress made to date on the plan, and that, to
16 constitute official City policy, such revision must be adopted by the Board of Supervisors.
