RESOLUTION NO. 764-0

[CEQA Findings for 525 Golden Gate City Administrative Building]

Resolution affirming certification of the Final Environmental Impact Report and adopting environmental findings pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act and State Guidelines in connection with adoption of General Plan Amendment, Zoning Map Amendment and other actions to approve development and construction of City Administrative Building located at 525 Golden Gate Avenue.

WHEREAS, The proposed City Administrative Building is located at 525 Golden Gate Avenue, on Lot 1 of Assessor's Block 766; and

WHEREAS, The Project would consist of a 12/14-story, 156/181-foot tall City Administrative Building containing approximately 215,000/255,500 square feet of office space with basement parking levels, housing approximately 800-950 City employees (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department ("Department") has undertaken an environmental review process for the proposed Project and provided for appropriate public hearings before the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, The actions listed in Attachment A hereto (the "Actions") are part of a series of considerations in connection with approval of the Project, as more particularly defined in Attachment A hereto; and

WHEREAS, On September 23, 2000, the Department released for public review and comment the Draft Environmental Impact Report for the Project; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission held a duly advertised public hearing on the Draft Environmental Impact Report on October 26, 2000 and further written public comments were received until 5:00 p.m. on November 7, 2000; and

WHEREAS, A Final Environmental Impact Report ("FEIR") for the Project has been prepared by the Department, consisting of the Draft Environmental Impact Report, the comments received during the review period, any additional information that became available and the Draft Summary of Comments and Responses, all as required by law; and

WHEREAS, The FEIR files and other Project-related Department files have been available for review by this Board of Supervisors and the public, and those files are part of the record before this Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, On February 15, 2001, the Planning Commission reviewed and considered the FEIR and, by Motion No. 16092, found that the contents of the FEIR and the procedures through which the FEIR was prepared, publicized and reviewed complied with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the CEQA Guidelines and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, By Motion No. 16092, the Planning Commission found that the FEIR was adequate, accurate and objective, reflected the independent judgment and analysis of the Planning Commission and that the summary of Comments and Responses contained no significant revisions to the draft Environmental Impact Report, adopted findings of significant impacts associated with the Project and certified the completion of the Final Environmental Impact Report for the Project in compliance with CEQA and the CEQA Guidelines. A copy of said motion is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>011116</u> and is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, In Resolutions No. <u>16212 and \_\_\_\_\_</u>, the Planning Commission adopted Findings, as required by CEQA, regarding the alternatives and variants, mitigation measures and significant environmental impacts analyzed in the FEIR, <u>a statement of overriding considerations</u>, and a proposed mitigation monitoring program. Copies of such

resolutions are is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_011116\_\_\_\_ and is incorporated herein by reference; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department prepared proposed Findings, as required by CEQA, regarding all of the actions listed in Attachment A hereto, the alternatives and variants, mitigation measures and significant environmental impacts analyzed in the FEIR, <u>a statement of overriding considerations</u>, and a proposed mitigation monitoring program, which material was made available to the public and this Board of Supervisors for the Board of Supervisors' review, consideration and actions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors reviewed and considered Planning Commission Motion No. 16092 certifying the FSEIR and finding the FEIR adequate, accurate and objective, and reflecting the independent judgment and analysis of the Planning Commission, and hereby affirms the Planning Commission's certification of the FEIR; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors finds that (1) modifications incorporated into the Project will not require important revisions to the FEIR due to the involvement of new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects; (2) no substantial changes have occurred with respect to the circumstances under which the Project are undertaken which would require major revisions to the FEIR due to the involvement of new significant environmental effects, or a substantial increase in the severity of effects identified in the FEIR; and (3) no new information of substantial importance to the Project has become available which would indicate (a) the Project or the Actions will have significant effects not discussed in the FEIR, (b) significant environmental effects will be substantially more severe; (c) mitigation measures or alternatives found not feasible which would reduce one or more significant effects have become feasible; or (d) mitigation measures or alternatives which are considerably different

from those in the FEIR would substantially reduce one or more significant effects on the environment; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the FEIR and hereby adopts the Project Findings attached hereto as Attachment A, including its Exhibits 1 (the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program) and 2, and incorporates the same herein by this reference.
