4 Resolution urging the California Department of Aging and the
5 California Department of Health Services to approve of a second shift
6 for L'Chaim Adult Day Health Care, a program of Jewish Family and
7 Children's Services.

10 WHEREAS, L'Chaim Adult Day Health Care is a program of Jewish
11 Family and Children's Services and provides health care services
12 including nursing, rehabilitative, and social services for frail,
13 elderly, and disabled adults; and,

14 WHEREAS, L'Chaim Adult Day Health Care has operated at capacity
15 since it opened in July of 1999 and currently has over one hundred
16 potential clients who would utilize their services if capacity
17 allowed; and,

18 WHEREAS, This organization provides vital services to
19 monolingual Russian speakers who depend on L'Chaim Adult Day Health
20 Care staff who offer services in a culturally and linguistically
21 appropriate setting; and,

22 WHEREAS, L'Chaim Adult Day Health Care is an exemplary service
23 provider found to operate at, or above State standards by the
24 appropriate licensing agencies and was granted a two year license

1 after just one year of operation due to their outstanding level of
2 service; and,

3 WHEREAS, L'Chaim Adult Day Health Care has been working to
4 obtain permission for a second shift from the California Department
5 of Aging and the California Department of Health Services since April
6 of 2000; and,

7 WHEREAS, These State of California departments have recently
8 completed a re-evaluation of the practice of double shifts in adult
9 day health care facilities and now have new regulations in place
10 under which programs like L'Chaim Adult Day Health Care may operate
11 two shifts per day; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
13 of San Francisco hereby urges the California Department of Aging and
14 the California Department of Health Services to promptly evaluate and
15 approve of a second shift at the L'Chaim Adult Day Health Care.
