[Urging passage of HR1990 and S940]

Resolution urging the U.S. Congress to begin committee hearings and to enact HR1990 and S940, the Act to Leave No Child Behind.

WHEREAS, The Act to Leave No Child Behind (HR1990 and S940) is a comprehensive bill addressing a wide array of children's issues including hunger, welfare, housing, income support, health, education, gun violence, child abuse, and youth development; and,

WHEREAS, Eleven million American children currently do not have access to health care which has resulted in the rise of preventable health problems such as polio, lead poisoning, low birth weight babies, and high infant mortality rates; and,

WHEREAS, This legislation would ensure that every child and their parents have health insurance by establishing a system of health care, educational, family, and community supports that offer children at risk a more secure future; and,

WHEREAS, The Act to Leave No Child Behind will raise the living standards of twelve million American children now living in poverty by increasing the minimum wage, funding programs to increase involvement and financial support from non-custodial parents, creating a seamless system of child care and nutrition programs, and offering refundable child tax credits for working families; and,

WHEREAS, This bill will help thousands of poor children left behind in crumbling schools with unqualified teachers and old textbooks by funding school construction, teacher quality initiatives, early learning initiatives, and after school programs; and,

WHEREAS, State and federal resources have focused on aiding the one million American children abused each year, but have left prevention programs under funded; and,

WHEREAS, HR1990 and S940 offer states new federal child abuse assistance for preventive, protective, and crisis situations, and also provide assistance for children once they are adopted and for children transitioning out of foster care; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the U.S. Congress to begin committee hearings and to enact HR1990 and S940, the Act to Leave No Child Behind; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of the Supervisors shall transmit copies of this resolution to U.S. Senate Majority Leader Tom Daschle, Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives Dennis Hastert, U.S. Senator Christopher Dodd, and U.S. Congressman George Miller.
