Resolution approving settlement of San Francisco's potential claims for fines. penalties and damages against IBM, Ogilvy & Mather and Mindshare arising out of their participation in the stenciling of advertisements on City sidewalks. Under the settlement, the companies shall: (1) pay \$19,685.93 to San Francisco to reimburse the City for its out-of-pocket costs arising out of the incident; (2) make a \$100,000.00 payment to the San Francisco Clean City Program; (3) clean and remove any stenciled images found to be remaining on City property; and (4) refrain from participating in similar acts in the future. In exchange, San Francisco shall release the companies from potential claims arising out of the stencils and rescind a previous resolution relating to this subject.

WHEREAS, On April 18, 2001, the Department of Public Works began to receive complaints about advertising images stenciled on City sidewalks without the permission of the City and County of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS. The City publicly expressed its disapproval of the images by enacting Resolution No. 010783, which, among other things, required the Department of Public Works to track its costs in responding to the images and urged the City Attorney's Office to take certain action; and

WHEREAS, When International Business Machine Corporation, Ogilvy & Mather, a Division of the Ogilvy Group, and Mindshare USA, Inc. (hereafter, the "Companies") learned of the City's reaction to the images, they took immediate steps to cease the stenciling and to clean and remove the existing images from City sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, The Companies have expressed their commitment to cleaning and removing from City property any image not yet so cleaned and removed at no further expense to the City; and

WHEREAS, The Companies have also expressed their commitment to ameliorating any harm that the images caused to the City; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works incurred costs and expenses in the amount of \$10,755.93 in connection with the stenciled images; and

WHEREAS, The Office of the City Attorney performed services in connection with the incident in the amount of \$8,930.00; and

WHEREAS, The Companies and the City desire and have agreed to resolve any and all of the City's potential claims against the Companies for fines, penalties and damages arising out of their participation in the stenciling of advertisements on City sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, Under an agreement between the Companies and the City, the Companies shall (1) pay the city \$19,685.93 to reimburse the City for its out-of-pocket costs arising out of the images, (2) make a \$100,000.00 payment to the San Francisco Clean City Program, a nonprofit organization, (3) clean and remove any images reported to be remaining on City property through December 31, 2001, and (4) refrain from participating in similar acts in the future.

WHEREAS, Under the Agreement the City, in turn, shall release and discharge the Companies from any and all claims for fines, penalties and damages as a consequence of the images and rescind Board Resolution 010783; and

WHEREAS, On file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. , which sets forth the specific terms of the agreement between the Companies and the City, and which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The issues and concerns that were stated in Board Resolution 010783 have been addressed and resolved to the City's satisfaction pursuant to this agreement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the agreement between the City and the Companies set forth herein is approved and that Board Resolution 010783 is rescinded.
