8 WHEREAS, At 7AM on January 15, 2002, a fire broke out at the four unit apartment
9 building at 19th and Potrero Street with many unsuspecting residents trapped inside; and,

10 WHEREAS, While driving to work, Daniel Elzie saw black smoke coming out of the
11 building at 19th and Potrero; and,

12 WHEREAS, Acting on his quick wit, Daniel immediately alerted the Fire Department of
13 the location of the fire then rushed to the entrance, where he started ringing door bells,
14 banging on doors, and throwing pebbles at windows ; and,

15 WHEREAS, As a result of Daniel Elzie's selfless and heroic act, he rescued 14 people
16 and a dog out of the burning apartment, and; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
18 extends its highest commendation in recognition of Daniel Elzie for his selfless and heroic act
19 on January 15, 2002 which saved 14 lives.


