3 Resolution authorizing the Mayor's Criminal Justice Council to  
4 retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$592,198 from the  
5 Office of Criminal Justice Planning (OCJP) for the purpose of implementing  
6 local juvenile justice accountability measures through the Juvenile  
7 Accountability Incentive Block Grant program (JAIBG),

10 WHEREAS, MCJC is the lead programmatic and fiscal agency in  
11 administering the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant, which provides  
12 funds for juvenile programs that ensure graduated sanctions and accountability  
13 measures; and

14 WHEREAS, the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council of San Francisco  
15 has previously reviewed and approved the JAIBG expenditure plan; and

17 WHEREAS, OCJP issued the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block  
18 Grant (JAIBG) PLUS Request for Applications to augment the current JAIBG  
19 grant for a total of \$1,184,396; and

20 WHEREAS, funds issued through the PLUS application are one time in  
21 nature; and


22 WHEREAS, the positions authorized under the grant are designated as "G" or  
23 "Grant Funded" positions which would terminate when the grant expires; and

1 WHEREAS, the funding available provides continuation funding for  
2 existing programs and funding for new one time program and equipment  
3 expenses; and


4 WHEREAS, in order to maximize direct services indirect costs are  
5 requested to be waived; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco hereby  
7 authorizes MCJC to retroactively accept and expend \$592,198 from  
8 OCJP, State of California, to administer the Juvenile Accountability  
9 Incentive Block Grant Program.  
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




