Resolution proclaiming the month of May, 2002, as Mental Health Month in the City and County of San Francisco.

WHEREAS, Mental health is indispensable to individual well-being, interpersonal and family relationships, and full and fulfilling community and social interaction; and

WHEREAS, Mental health is the underlying base for cognitive and communication skills, learning, emotional growth, resilience and self-esteem; and,

WHEREAS, Mental health and physical health are inextricably intertwined; and, WHEREAS, Mental illness ranks second in the burden of disease in developed countries such as the United States; and

WHEREAS, the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness are complicated by additional considerations such as language barriers and cultural differences, as well as by factors such as substance abuse; and

WHEREAS, the stigma still associated with mental illness deters those suffering from mental illness from seeking treatment, and results in isolation, depression, and loss of selfesteem; and

WHEREAS, the stigma still associated with mental illness reduces sufferers' access to resources and opportunities, deprives sufferers of their dignity, and may result in overt discrimination and abuse; and

WHEREAS, the stigma still associated with mental illness reduces general knowledge of the validity, causes and consequences of mental illness; and therefore also of the imperative need for continuing research, treatment, and understanding of mental illness; now, therefore, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco call on its residents, public and private agencies, institututions, businesses, schools and colleges to increase awareness and understanding of mental illness, and to recognize and respond to the need for appropriate and accessible services for those suffering from mental illness; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco commend all those – individuals, non-profit and public agencies, and other organizations and entities – who help those suffering from mental illness.
