3 **RESOLUTION URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO BOARD OF EDUCATION TO FULFILL**  
4 **THEIR COMMITMENT TO "EXCELLENCE FOR ALL" AND TAKE ACTION TO RELOCATE**  
5 **PHOENIX HIGH SCHOOL TO THE CURRENT SCHOOL OF THE ARTS CAMPUS WHICH**  
6 **IS A MORE EDUCATION-FRIENDLY AND SAFE ENVIRONMENT.**

8 WHEREAS, The current location of Phoenix High School (1950 Mission, between 15<sup>th</sup>  
9 and 16<sup>th</sup> Street) is not suitable for acceptable educational quality; and,

10 WHEREAS, The area surrounding the school does not resemble an educational  
11 environment, but a hazardous one; and,

12 WHEREAS, In the current location, students are bombarded with images and  
13 experiences with drug dealers, prostitution, and gang violence; and,

14 WHEREAS, As reported by faculty members. last year over three students were  
15 recruited into prostitution and many more into drug dealing and using; and,

16 WHEREAS, Students at Phoenix High School take classes in bungalows and have no  
17 access to a library, limited cafeteria, or limited recreational area; and,

18 WHEREAS, County Community School students deserve an equal opportunity to  
19 receive a decent education and a sense of hope in higher education; and,

20 WHEREAS, The students at Phoenix High School are less motivated to succeed and  
21 excel due to the influences of their surroundings; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the San Francisco  
23 Board of Education to fulfill their commitment to "Excellence For All" and take action to  
24 relocate Phoenix High School to the current School of the Arts campus which is a more  
25 education-friendly and safe environment.


