

1 [Resolution to Initiate the Designation of the Dogpatch Historic District]

3 **Resolution initiating the designation of the Dogpatch Historic District pursuant to**  
4 **Section 1004.1 of the Planning Code.**

6 WHEREAS, The area known and described in this resolution as Dogpatch is an  
7 approximately nine-block enclave of industrial workers' housing located east of Potrero Hill, in  
8 San Francisco's Central Waterfront district; and,

9 WHEREAS, The area comprising the proposed Dogpatch Historic District is significant  
10 under National Register Criterion A (Patterns of History) within the category of Industry, as the  
11 oldest and most intact concentration of industrial workers' housing in San Francisco and  
12 under the category of Exploration/Settlement, as the first housing developed in the Potrero  
13 District; and,

14 WHEREAS, The area comprising the proposed Dogpatch Historic District is significant  
15 under National Register Criterion C (Design/Construction) as a moderately intact district of  
16 mostly Victorian and Edwardian-era workers' dwellings constructed between 1870 and 1910;  
17 and,

18 WHEREAS, The area comprising the proposed Dogpatch Historic District contains a  
19 number of structures having a special character and special historical, architectural and  
20 aesthetic interest and value, and constitutes a distinct section of the City; and

21 WHEREAS, An ordinance amending the Planning Code by adding Appendix L  
22 designating the Dogpatch Historic District is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors  
23 in File No. ; now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby initiate the  
25 designation of the Dogpatch Historic District, whose boundaries are generally found between:

1 Minnesota and Tennessee Streets, odd and even addresses, from 18th Street to Tubbs  
2 Street, Blocks/Lots: 3996/4; 4043/1, 5-7, 9-14, 17; 4060/15; 4106/1-3, 14-16, 2E, 2F, 2G, 2L,  
3 2M, 2O, 25; 4107/1-21, 2H, 5A, 9A, 11B; 4108/1-5, 12-15, 18-19, 1B, 2A, 2B, 2C, 2I, 2J, 2K,  
4 2N, 3C, 3E, 3G, 3H, 3O, 3P, 14A; and 4171/2-3, 6-11, 34, 34B, 36; 4172/2, 4, 5, 6, 11, 13, 18,  
5 25, 27-29, 32, 35, 011B, 018A, 031, 032, and so directs the Landmarks Preservation Advisory  
6 Board to place the property in consideration as an Historic District pursuant to Article 10 of the  
7 Planning Code and other appropriate provisions of law.
