WHEREAS, Market Street Railway was founded in 1976 for the specific task of saving a 1948 trolley from disposal; and,

WHEREAS, Its current mission is to preserve and embrace historic transit in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, Market Street Railway accomplishes this by supporting MUNI in daily operation of the vintage streetcars, acquiring, detailing and restoring additional historic streetcars and creating authentic signage for the streetcars; and,

WHEREAS, Market Street Railway also educates the public on the historic importance of mass transportation and the history of public transportation in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, As a 1,200-member non-profit, Market Street Railway played a crucial role in establishing the F-line in 1995, which has become one of the most successful vintage streetcar lines in the world; and,

WHEREAS, The Market Street Railway has restored more than twenty vintage vehicles and is currently restoring a Russian tram from 1912 and a San Francisco streetcar from 1924; and,

WHEREAS, Market Street Railway is working to establish a new historical streetcar line, the E-line from the Wharf to Pacific Bell Park; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco and the Board of Supervisors
2 commends the Market Street Railway for its work in maintaining and promoting Historical




