[Accept-Expend Regional Grant]

Resolution authorizing the Director of Transportation or his designee to retreactively apply for, accept and expend \$112,000 in FY 02/03 Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (Air District) to stripe and sign bike lanes on Cabrillo Street and to execute any and all associated documents.

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 434 created the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the Bay Area, and provided authority to the Air District to impose up to a \$4.00 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees within its jurisdiction, to be used to implement specified transportation control measures; and

WHEREAS, On October 16, 1991, the Air District approved a \$2.00 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees, and raised the surcharge to \$4.00 effective April 1, 1993; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco supports the Bay Area Clean Air Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic's Bicycle Program has identified a \$140,000 project to stripe bike lanes on Cabrillo Street (Arguello Boulevard to La Playa Street); and

WHEREAS The Department of Parking and Traffic Bicycle Program has identified \$28,000 in San Francisco County Transportation Authority Measure B half-cent sales tax Bicycle, Pedestrian, Elderly and Disabled Access Projects (Category 47c) that will be requested as the local match; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 503-02 on July 29, 2002 authorizing the City Administrator to apply for a grant in the amount of \$1.15 million from

the Bay Area Air Quality Management District for the purpose of implementing programs to improve air quality, including the project to stripe bike lanes on Cabrillo Street; and

WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors approved Resolution No. 02-148 on December 3, 2002 authorizing the Director of Transportation or his designee to accept and expend \$112,000 in FY 02/03 Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District to stripe and sign bike lanes on Cabrillo Street and to execute any and all associated documents; and

WHEREAS, Calculating and claiming indirect costs using the methodology required by the Air District would require additional expense and reduce the funds available for program delivery; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorize the Director of Transportation or his designee to accept and expend \$112,000 in FY 02/03 Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District to stripe and sign bike lanes on Cabrillo Street, waving indirect costs, and to execute any and all associated documents.
