Resolution authorizing the Police Department to retroactively accept and expend a grant from the State of California Controller's Office for funding technology-related acquisitions to enhance public safety.

WHEREAS, In the 2002-2003 State budget, the State of California Controller's Office has made funding available through the California Law Enforcement Equipment Program (CLEEP) to ensure that all California's front-line peace officers have the resources they need in order to effectively fight crime and maintain order in the community; and,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a grant award notification has been received from the State of California; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City & County of San Francisco will adhere to the intended use and reporting requirements of the State of California Controller's Office regarding the California Law Enforcement Equipment Program (CLEEP) and all conditions specified in the grant agreement, and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco the attached Grant Award including any extensions and funding augmentations from the State of California Controller's Office, or amendments thereof; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to accept and expend continued funding, for this project, and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of this Grant Award, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency, and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
