Resolution approving Contract Amendment No. 3 to Paratransit Broker Agreement with ATC/Vancom, Inc., the City's Paratransit Broker, to increase the total amount of the Agreement to a sum not to exceed \$92,641,933 77,333,277, in order to meet the increased demand and costs for paratransit service during the contract period.

WHEREAS, On January 4, 2000, the Public Transportation Commission passed Resolution No. 00-003, which approved the Agreement Between the City and County of San Francisco and Comsis Mobility Services, Inc., dba Intelitran ("Paratransit Broker Agreement"), to administer the City's Paratransit Program, which Agreement was approved by the Board of Supervisors under Resolution No. 104-00, dated February 18, 2000; and,

WHEREAS, The Paratransit Agreement commenced on April 1, 2000, for a term of five years; and,

WHEREAS, On April 1, 2001, the Director of Transportation approved Amendment No. 1 to the Paratransit Broker Agreement, which incorporated an Incentive/Disincentive Program into the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, On December 18, 2001, the Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors (MTA Board) approved Resolution No. 01-126, which approved Amendment No. 2 to the Paratransit Broker Agreement, for the sublease of 24 ramped minivans to paratransit taxi service providers, which Amendment was approved by the Board of Supervisors under Resolution No. 70-02, dated January 28, 2002; and,

WHEREAS, On August 11, 2003, the MTA Board approved an Assignment and Assumption Agreement, under which the Paratransit Broker Agreement was assigned from

COMSIS to ATC/Vancom, Inc., doing business in California as ATC/Van der Aa Group, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency has determined that the Paratransit Broker Agreement budget must be increased to a sum not to exceed \$92,641,933 
77,333,277, \$92,641,933, in order to meet the increased demand for and costs of paratransit service during the contract period; and

WHEREAS, On October <u>-7</u>, 2003, the MTA Board passed Resolution No. <u>-03-164</u>, which approved Amendment No. 3 to the Paratransit Broker Agreement, and urged the Board of Supervisors to approve the Amendment; <u>and</u>

WHEREAS. The Board of Supervisors wishes to increase expenditures authorized under the contract to \$77,333,277 -- an amount sufficient to meet the increased demand for and costs of paratransit service through June 30, 2004; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves Amendment No. 3 to the Paratransit Broker Agreement with ATC/Vancom, Inc., to increase the amount of the Paratransit Broker Agreement by \$26,308,656 11,308,656, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$92,641,933 77,333,277.
