16 achievements in childcare, as well as address persisting child-care related problems; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Week of the Young Child will honor individuals who have made
18 outstanding contributions to the child-care profession and who improve the quality of life for
19 children and families in San Francisco; and,

20 WHEREAS, One in ten children in San Francisco has asthma and are undiagnosed,
21 and the Week of the Young Child will provide professionals to address this persisting problem
22 in our community; and,

23 WHEREAS, The Week of the Young Child will provide information for anyone


