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4 **Resolution urging City Departments to share departmental database data for an**

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8 WHEREAS, City Departments gather and maintain a wide variety of invaluable, yet  
9 underutilized data, such as demographic, population, and budgetary information; and

10 WHEREAS, City Departmental data could be used to encourage community  
11 development and decision making, to produce updated lists of community services, to  
12 increase efficiency and efficacy of services, and to connect people with organizations that  
13 purport to represent them; and

14 WHEREAS, Information on community serving programs provided by public agencies  
15 is public information under the Federal Freedom of Information Act, the California Public  
16 Records Act, and the San Francisco Sunshine Ordinance, which is hereby declared to be a  
17 part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, This information it is not currently organized, maintained or disseminated  
19 in a cohesive way for the public to access; and,

20 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Survival Manual has collected and disseminated  
21 information for all SF populations, community organizations, government bodies and  
22 advocacy groups for 35 years; and

23 WHEREAS, The volunteer staff of the San Francisco Survival Manual will provide all  
24 principal labor involved in making the database data user friendly for the public; and  
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1           WHEREAS, The operation of this information clearinghouse will be based on grants  
2 and community fiscal sponsorship and will be at no expense to the city; now, therefore, be it

3           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby urges City Departments to share  
4 all database data to which the public is lawfully entitled with The San Francisco Survival  
5 Manual when requested for the purposes of a community based informational pilot project.
